Statement for compliance of regulation (EU) 2019/1021, Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs)

The Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants is a global treaty to protect human health and the environment from chemicals that remain intact in the environment for long periods.

The Stockholm Convention on POPs was adopted in May 2001 and the regulation (EC) No 850/2004 entered into force on 17 May 2004. In June 20th, 2019 the regulations were replaced by (EU) 2019/1021, this to be more adapted to the Reach regulation.

Suzuki Garphyttan AB, as a worldwide supplier of advanced spring wire, is aware of the responsibilities for protecting the environment and human health.

By that, we continuously follow up the PoPs regulation to ensure the conformity of our products with the legalization.
