

Minimizing our environmental impact

We take environmental responsibility across all our sites and strive not only to comply with but also to exceed legal requirements. By partnering with suppliers who share our commitment we ensure that our products have the lowest possible climate and environmental impact.

Some of our targets within environmental are to:

- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions in scope 1 & 2* to 134 kg CO₂e/ton wire, a reduction of 83 percent in 2030 compared to the baseline year 2020.
- Optimize water consumption in our operation and reduce the volume of wastewater generated, the total water consumption within our operations is to be 700 liters per ton of wire produced in 2030.
- Reduce the amount of waste within our operations and managing it in alignment with the highest levels of the waste hierarchy.

Investing in employees and the community

Our people are the key to our continued success and development. To attract and keep the expertise we need, we are committed to building an inclusive, diverse, and fundamentally safe workplace. We have a clear Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) strategy.

Some of our targets within social are to:

- Have zero workplace accidents, by maintaining a strong focus on preventive measures and by that continue to ensure a safe and sound environment for every employee.
- Offer fair, competitive, and equitable working conditions globally, in accordance with applicable laws and local regulations.
- Contribute to society with an approach based on local relevance. The ambition is that all sites should have at least one active CSR partnership that reflects their needs and opportunities.

Managing risks and capturing opportunities

We manage risks in a changing world with strong governance. Combining strict ethical guidelines with active supply chain management, we protect our daily operations and reduce vulnerabilities. This stability is the foundation we need to safely expand into new segments and drive long-term business transformation.

Some of our targets within governance are to:

- Establish clear responsibilities, effective control mechanisms and transparent reporting.
- Integrate sustainability in business planning, which is based on a five-year perspective, translating long-term strategic priorities into annual plans and targets.
- Maintain a strong corporate culture where both ethics and compliance are integral to daily operations, by integrity, transparency, and respect for applicable laws.

Carbon footprint

At Suzuki Garphyttan, reducing our carbon footprint is central to our environmental efforts. As an energy-intensive business, we recognize the climate impact of our operations and are committed to achieving net-zero emissions in our own activities. Our key drivers of emission reduction are:

1. The switch to fossil-free electricity: approx. 62% of all electricity used in 2025 came from fossil-free sources.
2. To electrify our processes instead of using fossil energy.
3. Site-specific improvements such as various types of energy efficiency measures in process and buildings, for example replacing oil boilers with geothermal heating.

We've made significant progress in cutting greenhouse gas emissions:

- From 783 kg CO₂e/ton in 2020 down to 380 kg CO₂e/ton in 2025*.
- Target for 2030: 134 kg CO₂e/ton, an 83% reduction per ton of wire compared to 2020*.
- This also represents a 59% cut in absolute emissions, even as production volumes increase*.
- Our target is aligned with the Paris Agreement and the ambition to limit global warming to 1.5°C.

* Scope 1 - direct emissions from owned or controlled sources and Scope 2 Indirect emissions from purchased energy.
